Creative Skills:

- ◆ Design and create your own throne and crown
- ◆ Create your own coat of arms
- ◆ Using a variety of recyclable materials to build your own Tudor house
- ◆ Draw portraits of Henry VIII and his wives.
- ◆ Make a model of an Elizabethan flagship or pirate ship
- ◆ Create a shadow puppet theatre to retell the Spanish Armada story
- ◆ Create your own Tudor Rose – could be on top of a cake or sewn using materials from around the house
- ◆ Write your own play like Shakespeare and perform it for the people in your house.

History Skills:

- ◆ Create a menu of what they would have eaten (written or pictures)
- ◆ Research what life was like for a child during these periods.

Mathematical skills:

- ◆ Draw a map/plan of the inside of a Tudor or Elizabethan ship – can you include measurements?
- ◆ Research famous explorers during the Elizabethan times. Where did they explore? What did they discover? How far did they travel? Create a map of their journey; include coordinates on your map.
- ◆ Create a modern day explorers guide. Where would you explore? How far away is it? How much would it cost to travel there? How much would it cost to stay?
- ◆ Create symmetrical flowers, start with the Tudor Rose
- ◆ Make Tudor food, use your weighing and measuring skills - <https://www.english-heritage.org.uk/members-area/kids/tudor-england/#recipe>
- ◆ Create a time line/family tree for the Tudor and Elizabethan Royal Families
- ◆ Use 2D shapes to create your own stained glass window – base your image on a famous person from the Tudor era
