Have you ever thought about designing a sculpture?

A sculpture is art in 3d! It can be made by modelling, sticking or building any objects to create a masterpiece!

- **Barbara Hepworth** – she liked to create sculptures outside and created a whole garden of sculptures – she used the landscape to inspire her, you could base your sculpture on trees or hills or houses you might see out of your window! <https://www.tate.org.uk/kids/explore/who-is/who-barbara-hepworth>

1. Explore some of the famous artists I've suggested
2. Look around your house/garden (even on a daily walk) and see if there's natural objects or objects in the house you could collect to use (even recycling could work!)
3. Try designing and sketch out ideas – each person in your family could try and you could evaluate your designs.
4. Use your ideas and the objects you have found to create your sculpture! You could create it inside or outside and work together as a family – remember to ask people around you to help!
