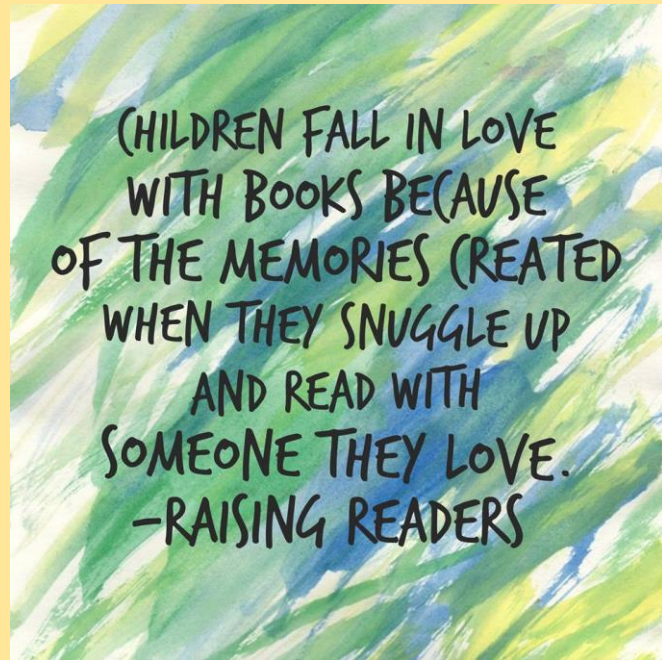

Phonics –teaching early reading

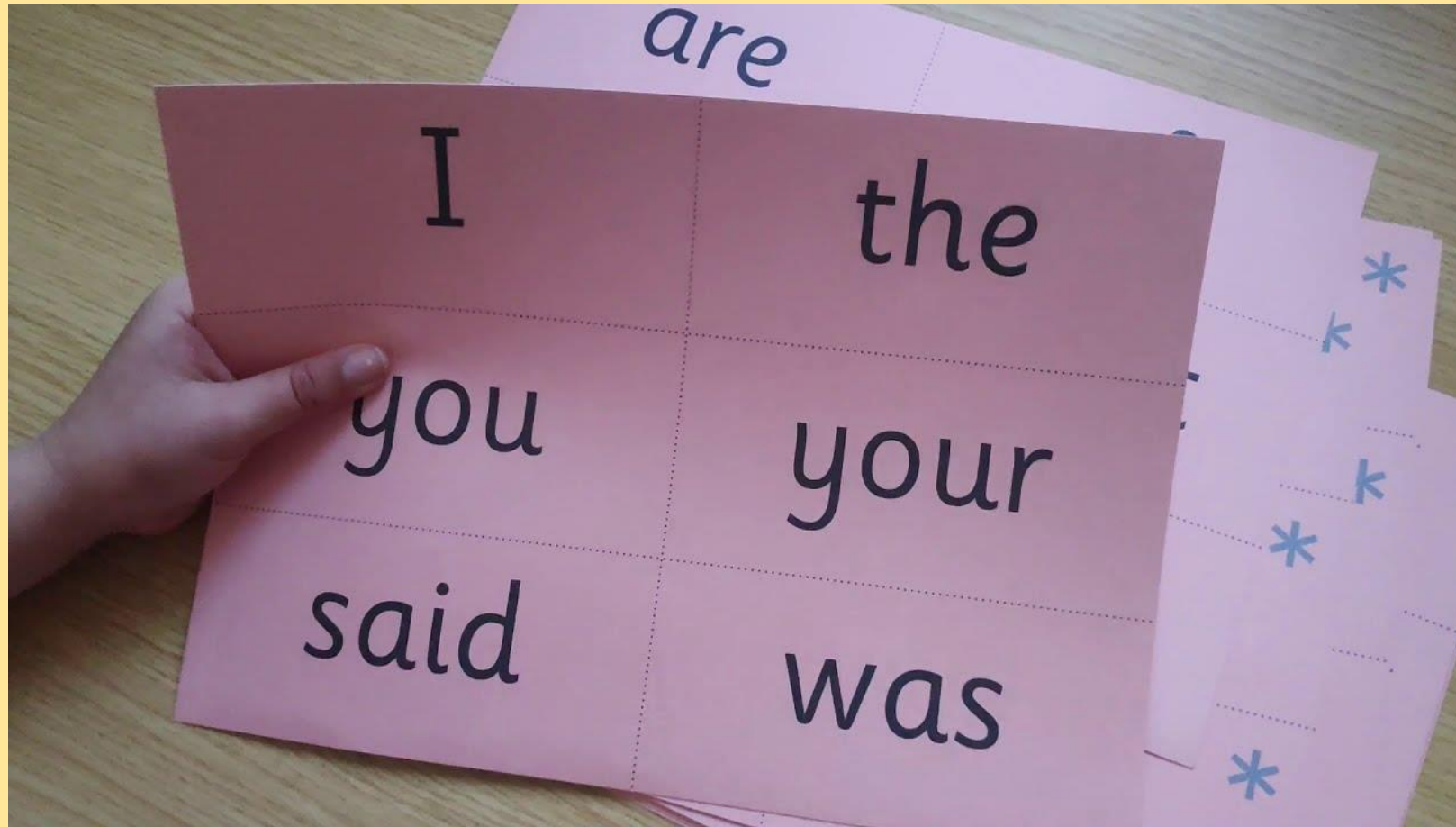
- ‘Fred talk’


